MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

between

UNIVERSITAS PEMBANGUNAN NASIONAL "VETERAN" YOGYAKARTA

and

TAIWAN 2+i COLLABORATION ALLIANCE UNIVERSITIES

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as "MOU") is a 2+i Collaboration Program between Universitas Pembangunan Nasional "Veteran" Yogyakarta and 6 Taiwan Universities. The objectives of the program are to improve the competencies of the D3 Indonesian Vocational Higher Education students to continue their bachelor's degree in Taiwan Universities and have an industrial internship experience in Taiwan Industries.

All parties have reached the following arrangements:

Article 1. CURRICULA AND OUTPUT

- 1. The program consists of 2.5 to 3 academic years, including 1.5 (one and a half) years of professional in-class courses and 1 to 1.5 years of industrial internship. The off-campus industrial internships arranged by the Taiwan universities are aligned and consistent with the majors of the students.
- 2. The major and internship curriculum is offered and realigned by the 6 Taiwan 2+i Collaboration Alliance Universities.

Article 2. OBLIGATIONS

- 1. Universitas Pembangunan Nasional "Veteran" Yogyakarta shall:
 - a. Disseminate and offer the information about the program to the Indonesian students and make
 - an initial selection.

 b. Send the list of the initial selection result to the Taiwanese Universities, based on the submission of the proposal.
 - c. Recommend students to join the 2+i Program for students to receive the one-year tuition fee waiver.
 - d. Assist the selected students with visa applications.

2. Taiwanese Universities shall:

- a. Conduct a review and interview of the list selection results sent by Indonesian Vocational Higher Education.
- b. Issue the final selection results.
- c. Waive one year of the tuition fees.
- d. The internships of the students are arranged by Taiwanese Universities, who shall also ensure that the students are treated and paid in accordance with the laws and regulations applied in Taiwan.
- 3. All the matters not mentioned above become the responsibilities and personal expenses of each student.

Article 3. DURATION AND TERMINATION

- 1. This MOU shall enter into force on the date of this signature.
- 2. This MOU shall be in force for five years, subject from time to time to revision or modification by mutual consent. It shall be automatically extended for another 5 years if neither institution submits a written request to terminate the MOU with one year's prior notice.
- 3. Either Party may terminate this MOU at any time by giving written notification to the other Parties at least 6 months before the date this MOU is due to expire.
- 4. The cooperation programs in progress before the termination date shall not be affected by the expiration and the termination of this MOU, unless the Parties agreed otherwise.

Article 4. SETTLEMENT OF DIFFERENCES

Any differences in the interpretation or application of this MOU shall be settled amicably by consultations or negotiation between the Parties.

Article 5. AMENDMENT

This MOU may be reviewed and amended at any time by mutual written consent of the Parties. Such revisions or amendments will come into effect on the date as may be determined by the Parties and will form an integral part of the arrangement.
